



# Australian Alpaca

ASSOCIATION

This alpaca fleece colour chart has been supplied to breeders to assist you in registering your alpacas into the correct fleece colour type.

1. Open the fleece on your animal and place the card next to the fleece as close to the skin as possible.
2. The natural range of alpaca fleece colours is more extensive than the colours on the chart so you must match the fleece to the nearest like colour.
3. Alpacas that are single in colour should be registered with the prefix (S) for solid preceding the described colour.
4. Alpacas that are predominantly one colour are to be registered as that colour but should not bear the prefix (S).
5. Grey alpacas are to be classified in the nearest grey category with no prejudice against light or dark markings.
6. Fancy coloured alpacas will be described by taking the largest colour body mass first and the lesser colour or colours next in order of body colour.

For example:

Black/White	BK/WT
White/Black	WT/BK
Medium Brown/White	MB/WT
White/Medium Brown	WT/MB
White/Medium Brown/Black	WT/MB/BK

The numbers shown next to the colour samples (at right) are international codes for these colours. When colour classing your alpaca please ignore these numbers and use the named colour description only.
